To subsidize gifted senior secondary students (i.e. S4-6 students) to take more structured learning opportunities of Gifted Education through school-based pull-out programmes and/or off-school support programmes (e.g. credit-bearing courses offered by tertiary education institutions, enhancement programmes offered by academic associations or professional bodies)

Total Amount of DLG: \$84000 (\$7000 per senior secondary class per year, a total of 12 S4-6 classes)

Summary of 2023-24:

The total expenses of DLG has been increased due to the resumption of serveal study tours. More S4 students particiapte in the Credit bearing courses of tertiary insitutions in different areas.

Suggestions for 2024-25:

Given that the gifted education programmes offered by tertiary institutions and professional bodies are costly (i.e. \$1000-\$5000) to most grassroot families in the school:

- For <u>CSSA and Full-Granted students</u>, about 50% of the programme fee could be subsidized by DLG while another 50% by School-based After-school Learning Support Grant (SALSG, recurrent) and/or Students Activities Support Grant (SASG, clawed back every year).
- For <u>Half-Granted and other NON-CSSA/Full/Half-Granted students</u>, about 50% of the programme fee could be subsidized by DLG while another 50% could be self-financed by themselves. In case the students express that their families cannot afford the programme fee, they could be given some subsidies through SALSG and/or SASG (i.e. by signing a circular to apply for "Special Half").
- > The DLG subsidy for each student in a year shall be capped at \$12000 and/or 3 programmes only.
